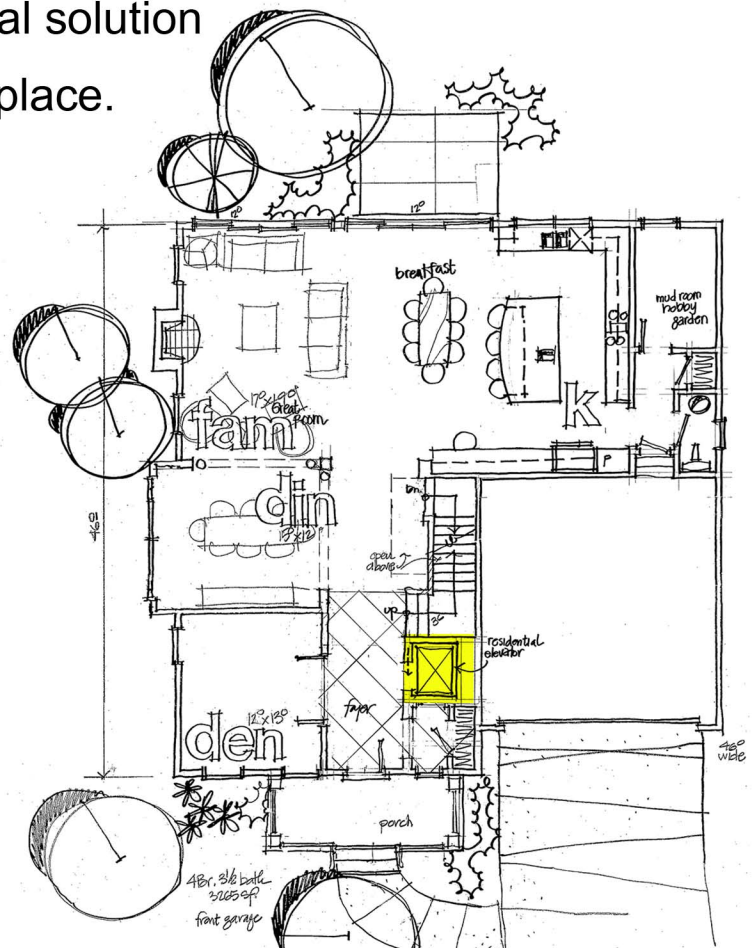
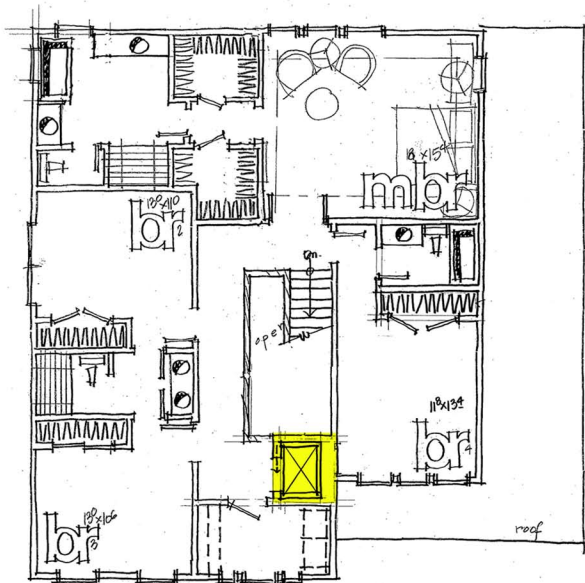
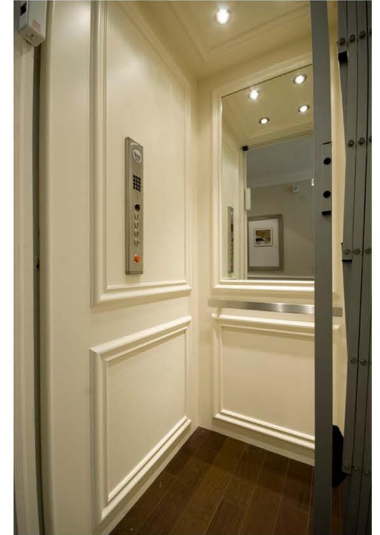


# "Rising" Concern
